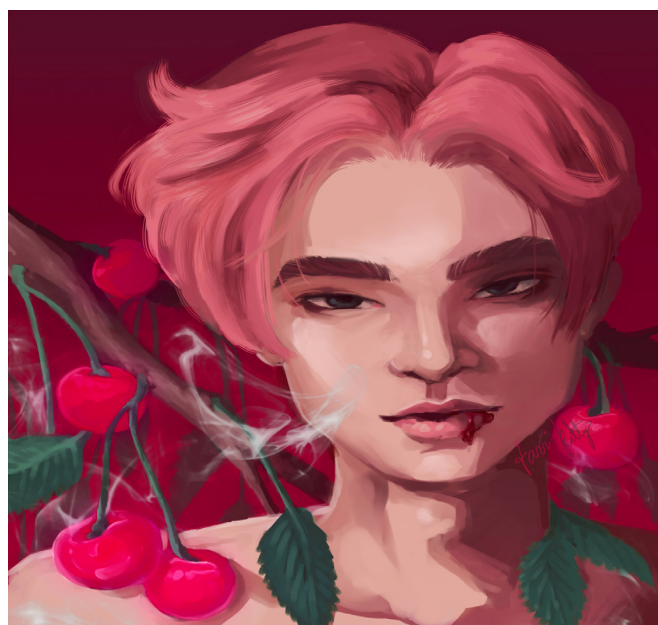
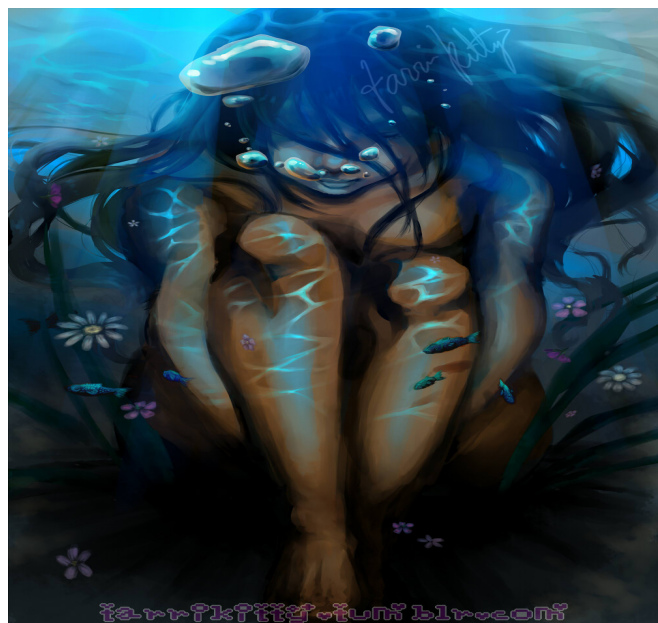

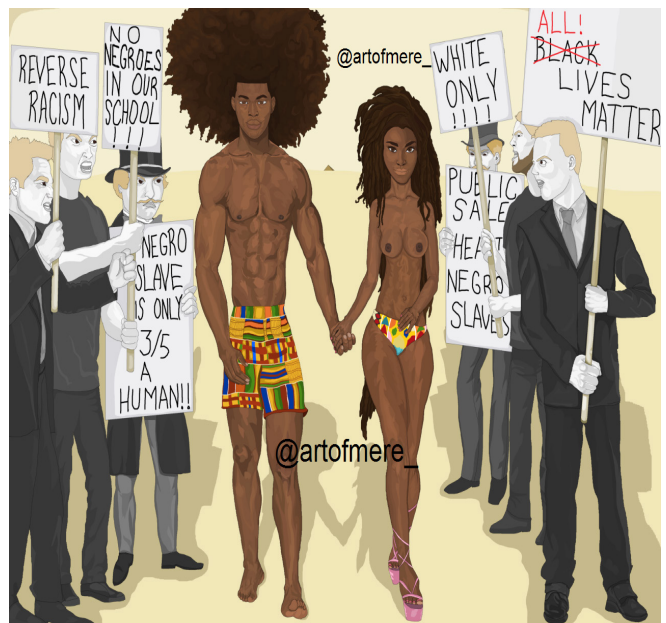

What experiences made you get into creating art?

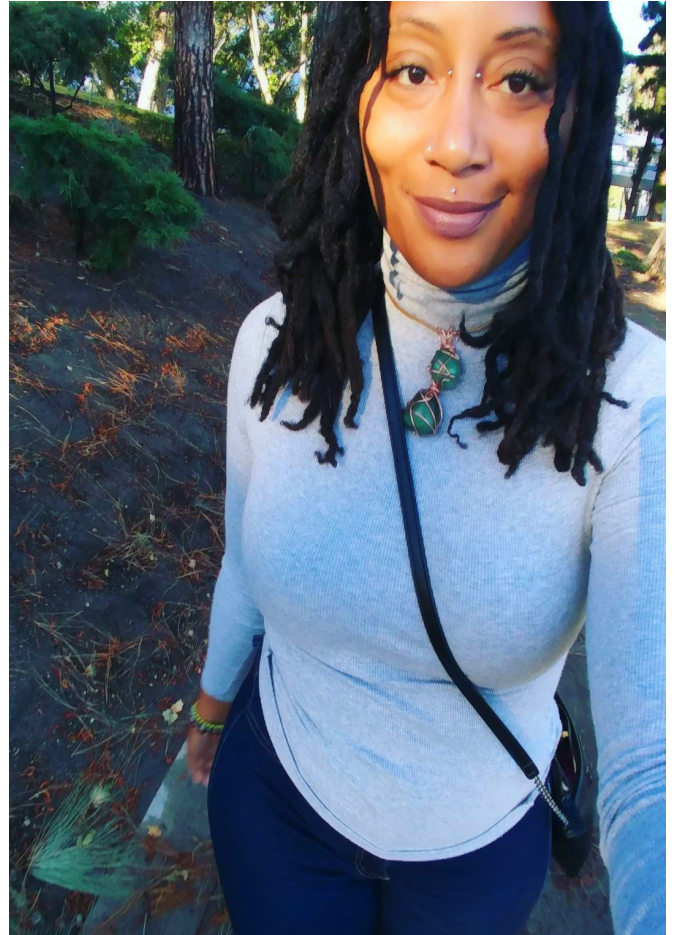
Where do you see your art going in the next three years?

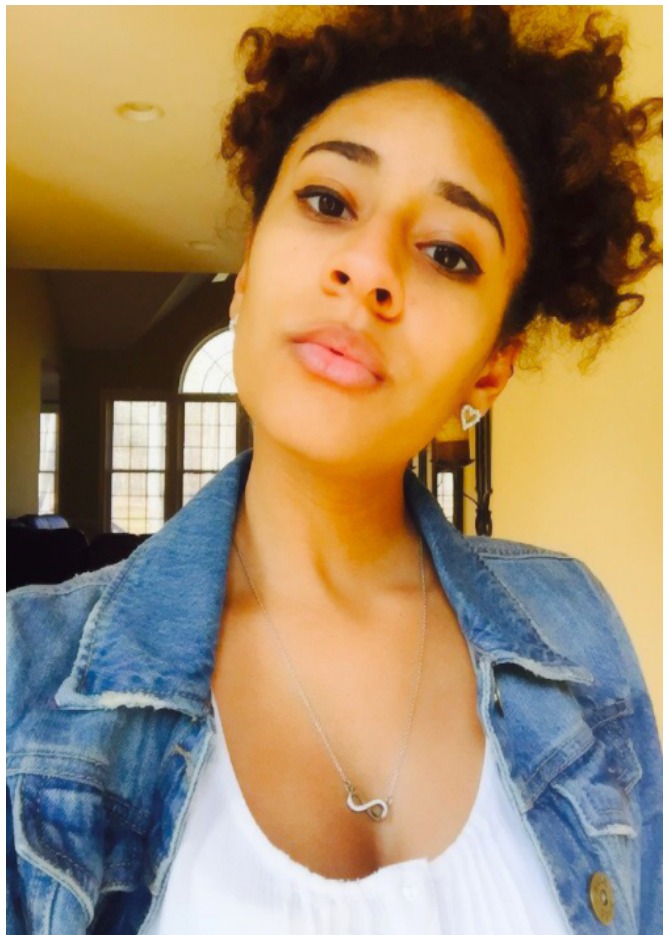
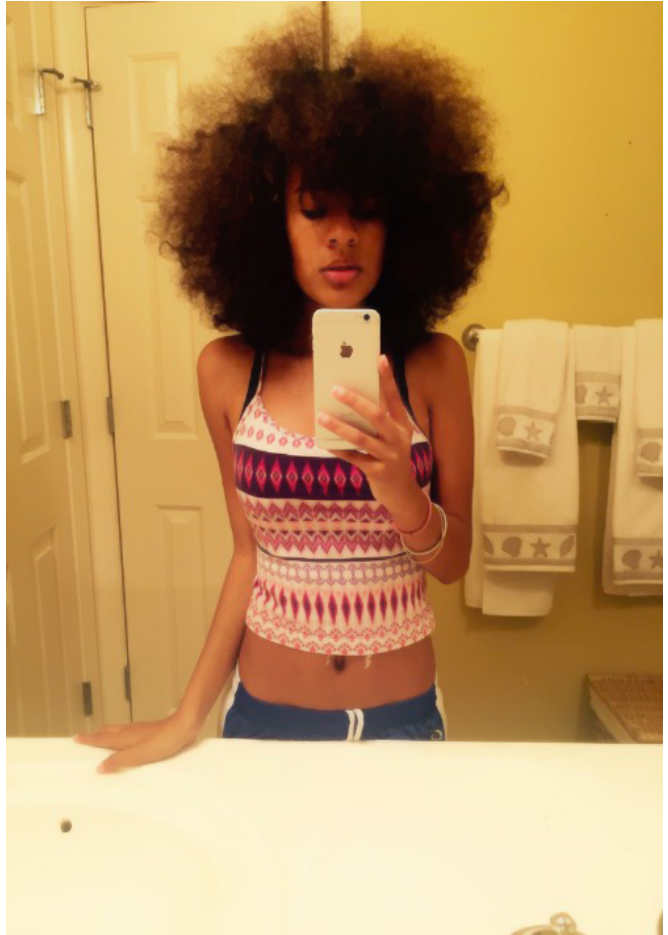

What gave you the idea to start a Youtube channel? What do you want to achieve with your Youtube channel?

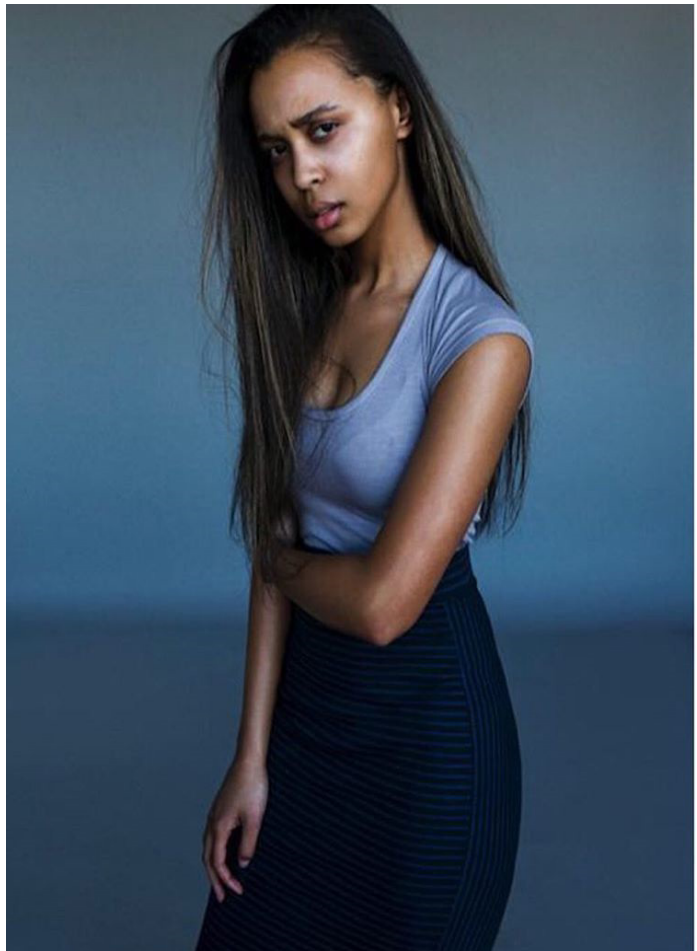
I started doing YouTube videos years ago.

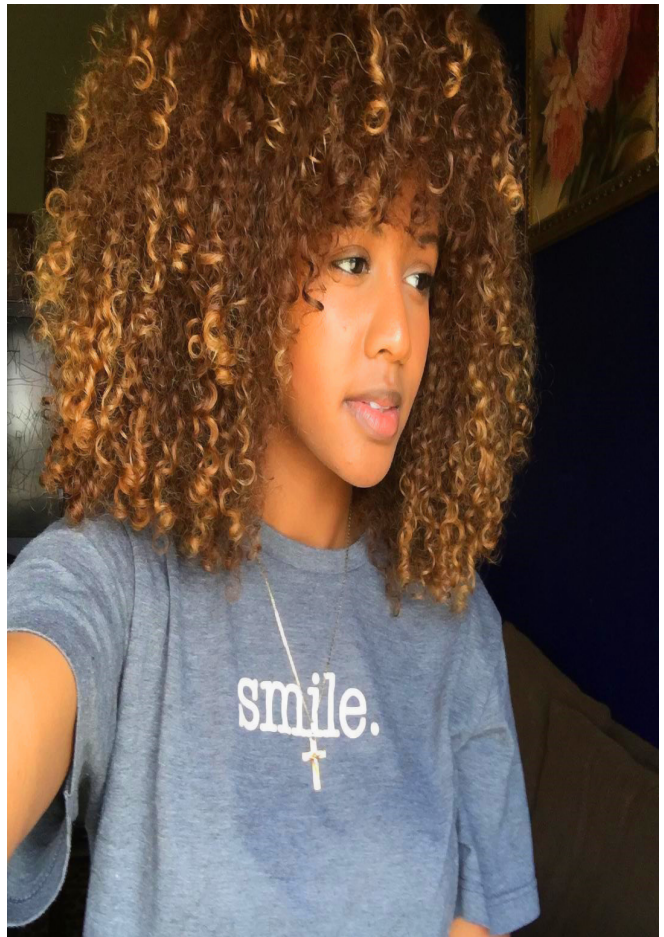

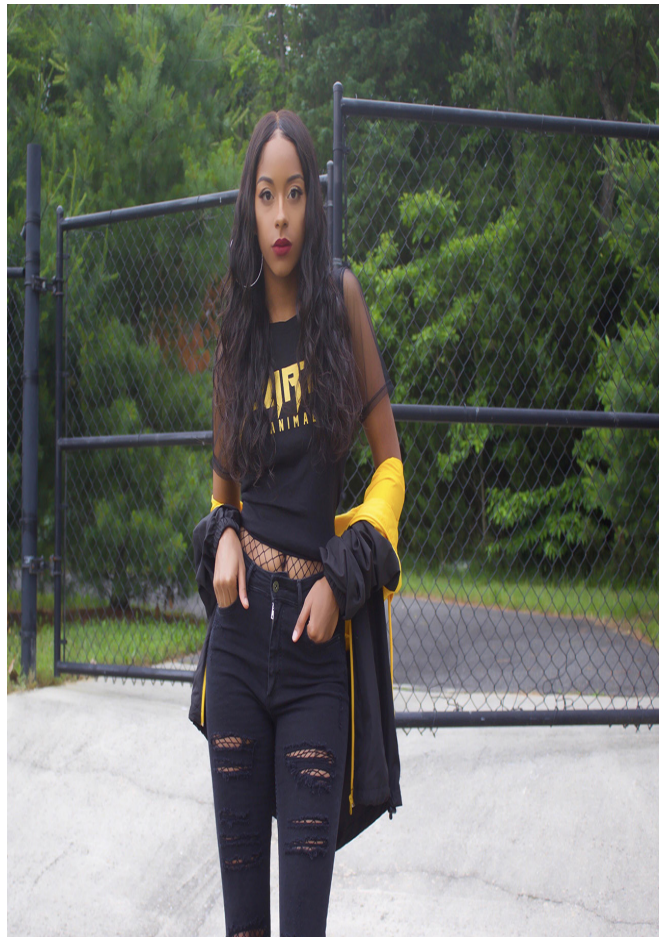

COMES - EP - SWEET NOISE/ JAMTOWN RECORDS

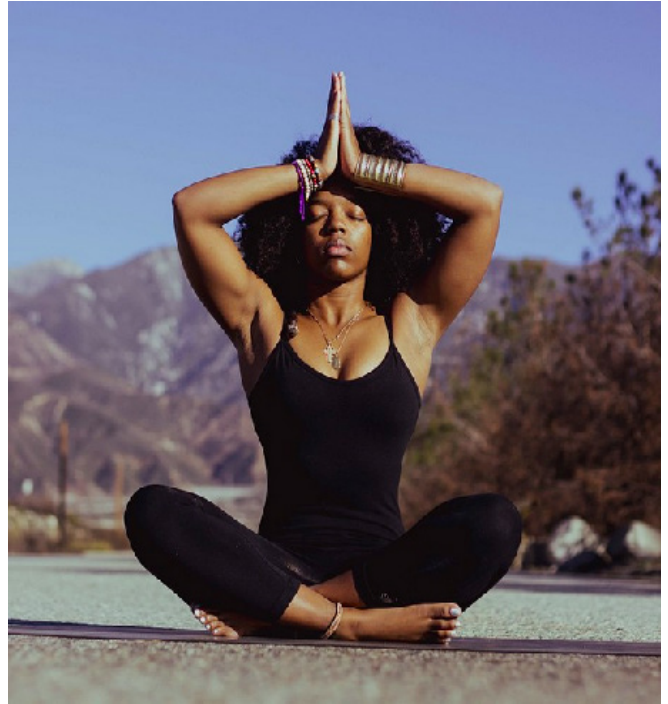

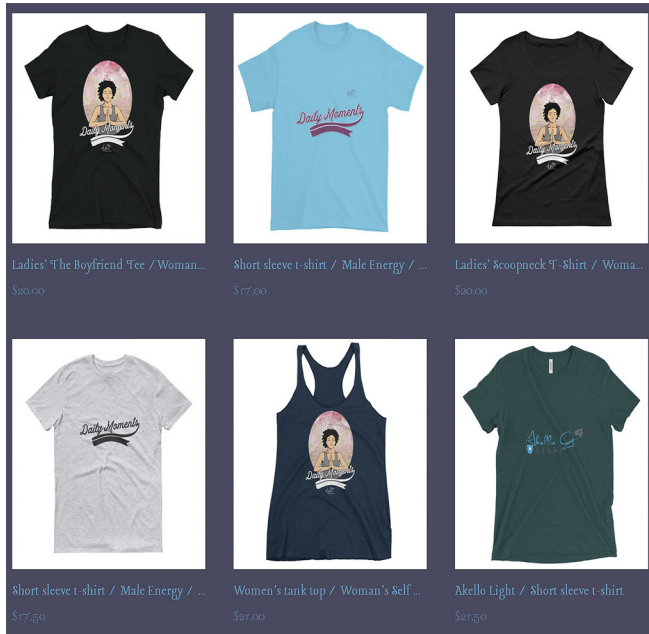
