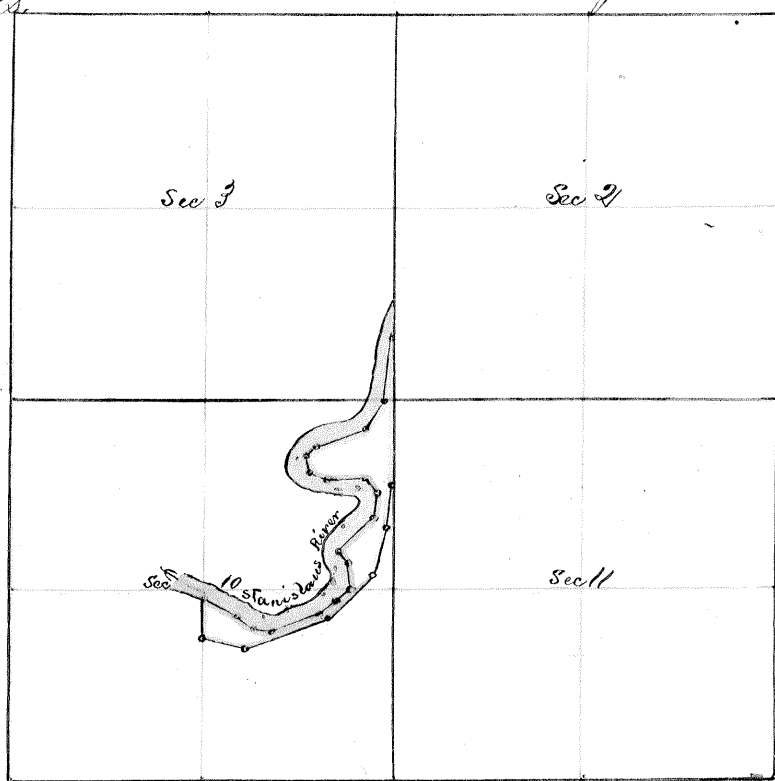

Field Notes.

Beginning at a post and mound set at intersection of the N & S line between sections 2 & 3. Township 3, south range, 7 east. with left bank of Stanislaus river, thence south 17.56 chains to a post and mound at the corner of sections 2, 3, 10 & 11. thence south 19.20 chains along U.S. meander line $S 3\frac{3}{4} W 8$ ch, $S 19 W 10$ ch, $S 49\frac{1}{2} W 14$ ch, $S 72\frac{1}{4} W 8$ ch, $N 75\frac{1}{2} W 8.70$ chains to a post and mound set at intersection with the North and South $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. line in sec 10, thence north 8.33 ch to the left bank of Stanislaus river, thence meander up stream $S 63\frac{3}{4} E 9$ ch, $S 37 E 4$ ch, $S 60\frac{1}{2} E 2$ ch, $N 72\frac{1}{4} E 12$ ch, $N 52 E 10$ ch, $N 16 W 10$ ch, $N 56 E 10$ ch, $N 8 E 4.50$ ch, $N 27\frac{1}{2} W 3.50$ ch, $S 84\frac{1}{2} W 12$ ch, $N 54 W 4$ ch, $N 5\frac{1}{2} W 2.50$ ch, $N 32\frac{1}{4} E 3.50$ ch, $N 76\frac{1}{4} E 11$ ch, $N 32\frac{1}{4} E 8$ ch, $N 8 E 18.04$ chains to point of beginning.

Run by the true Meridian; Magnetic Variation $15^{\circ} 45'$ East.
