Chaos UK/Doom/Filthkick/Dism-Bristol Hotel, Cardiff-25/11/89.

Woah! This is bloody punk rock! Small venue, lots of people, silly haircuts, loud music - the works! First up was the unskilled 'Barney' an ex-skinhead, who with the accompaniment of Stick (from Doom), took us through the golden years of rock'n'roll classics, it was awful and bloody funny too. Misars were the first band on and dam good they were too, an up and coming Welsh band playing in the vein of 80's Anarchopunk with melody and bollocks. They've got their 2nd demo and an EP coming out soon, so watch out for it. Filthkick were next, they are somewhat a H/C supergroup due to being made up of (apparently) members of Deviated Instinct, Heresy and Ripcord. The lead singer proceeded to drink a neat bottle of scotch throughout the set, which undoubtedly contributed to his vocal technique, anyhow they were good gruff punkcore but as yet nobody had danced (due to there being no actual dancefloor) It took the raging 'riffs' (massaa!) of Doom to move some asses including my own and Doom were as f\*cking brill as ever, despite having a permanently miserable lead singer. They played a new song called 'Dropout' which holds well for Doom's future. Next up were the stalwarts of the punk scene, Chaos UK, the grand-daddy's of Hardcore. Much to the amusement of fellow members Gabba was ill with Chicken pox and some poor bloke had to stand in and try and learn the chords in seconds, but the whole atmosphere was really friendly, the constant exchange of good natured verbal abuse added to this. Chaos UK didn't as far as I could tell, play anything off their new LP

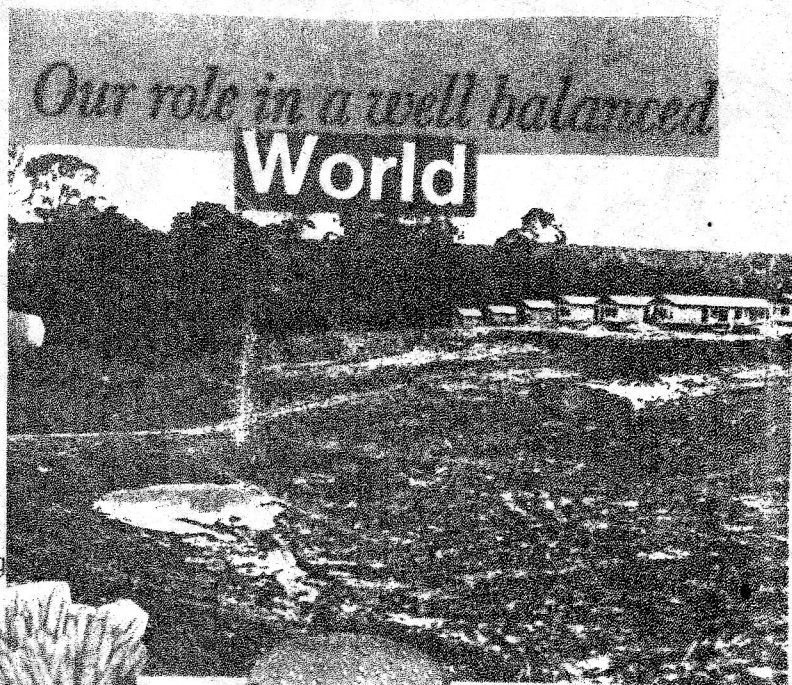
but went through their back catalogue of self proclaimed punk rock classics (4 minute warning, victimised etc). Cries from the drunken rabble of 'sower get your tits out' were luckily (for us all) ignored. On the whole a grand time was had by all, which is what it's about ain't it?

Extreme Noise Terror - 'One extreme to the other' video (Jettisound) Well, talk about bloody Capitalist Hardcore! £14.99 for this little baby (though I'm sure you must be able to get it cheaper). I didn't buy it but rather watched a mates copy. It's pretty good, really well filmed, good sound, colour and it's about an hour long.

It consists of E.N.T playing in London about ten numbers of their own inimitable style punk and an interview complete with mistakes and f\*ck ups.

The crowd on this video were truly 'punk as fuck' - real Exploited/GBH looking crowd and why bloody not? Long hair is still boring (Crapi - The Thrasholics) The interview is still the best because ENT come across as being pretty intelligent really, well probably better than your mum would give 'em credit for. \*Anything else you'd like to say?

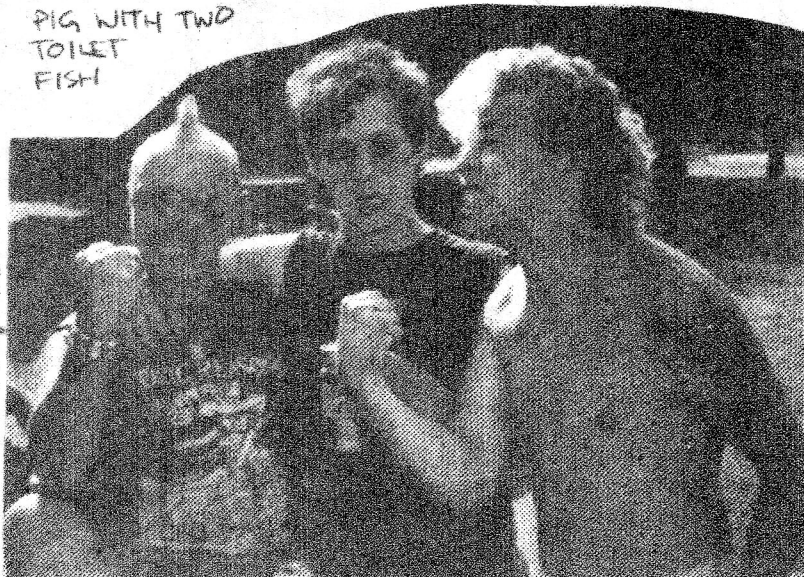
P-It's plug your mates, records, T-Shirts time.

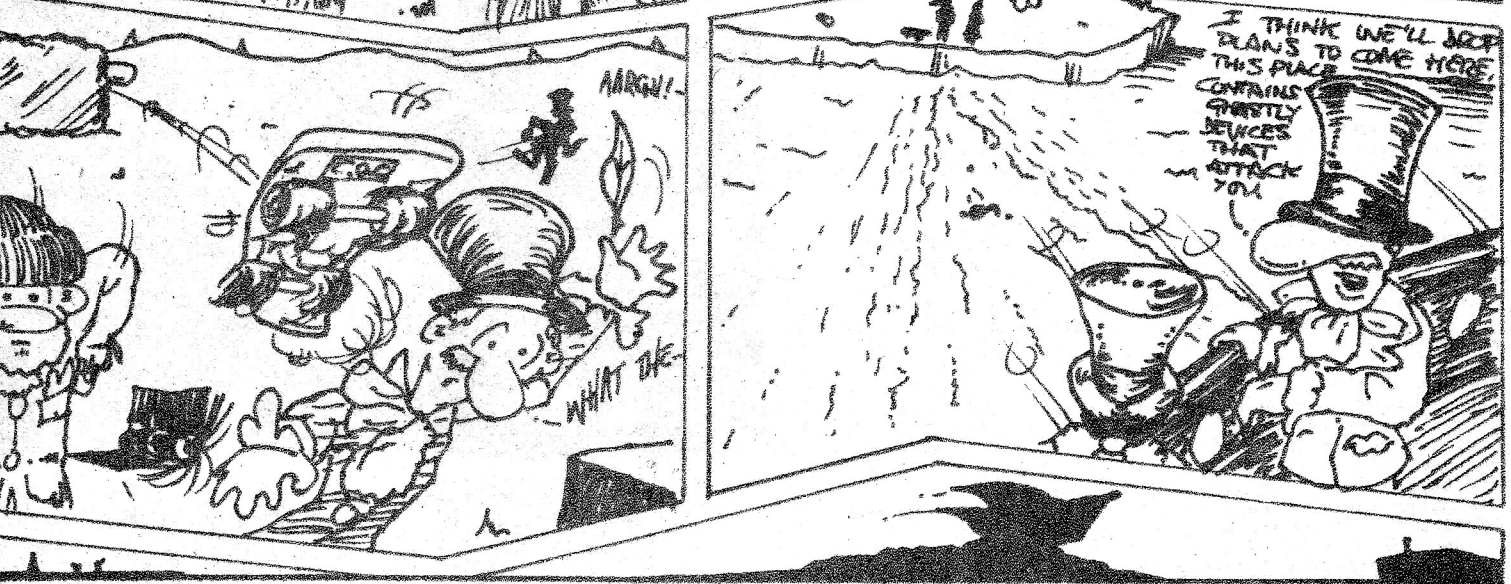
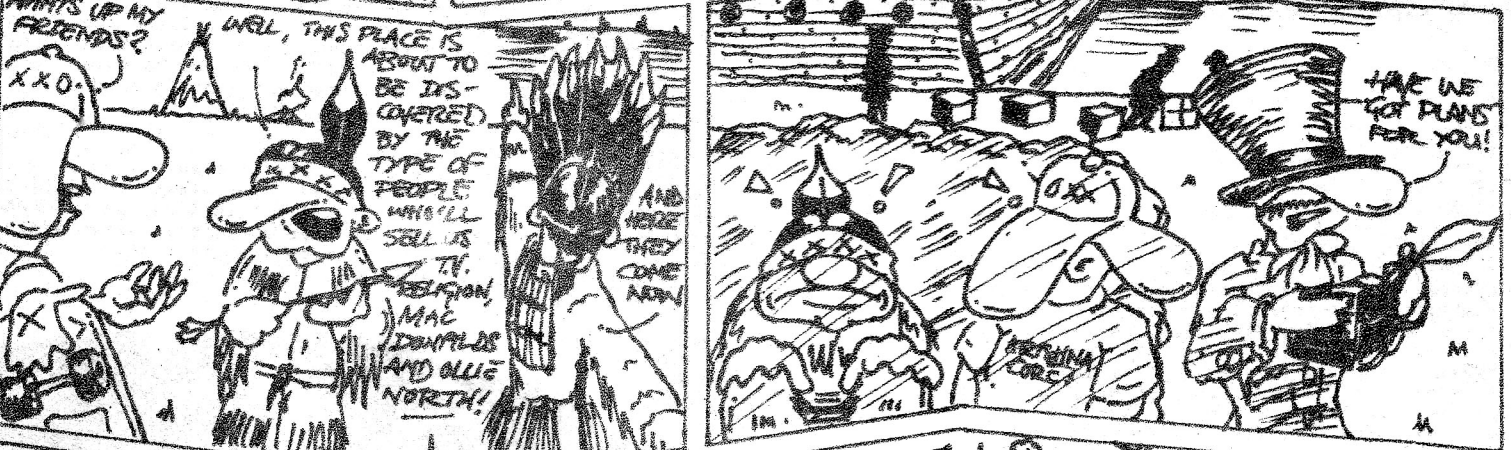
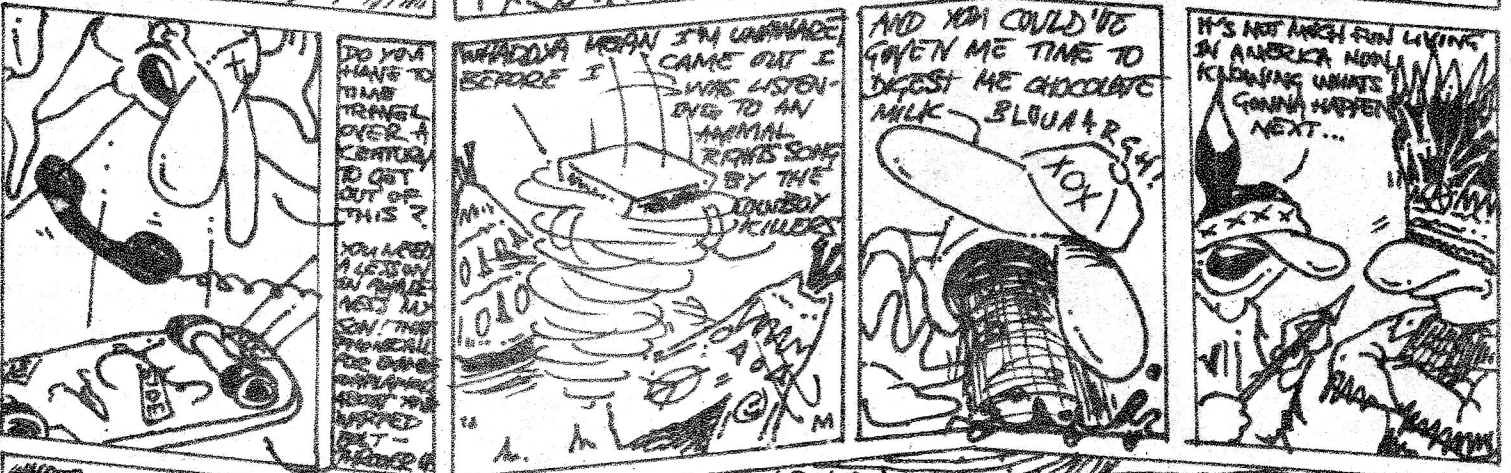
About products in general, well all of us are hypocrites, so let's get that straight, we are human, right?

# DISARM

Disarm are an up an' coming Welsh band who play punk rock in a kind of anarcho early-80's sound. The interview is conducted with Newt who plays bass and does backing vocals in the band...

1. I KNOW EVERYONE STARTS OFF THIS WAY, BUT GIVE US A BIRROVA INSIGHT INTO THE BACKGROUND OF THAT PHENOMENA THAT IS DISARM...  
Newt: I'd have to let Freeman or Paul answer this one as they are the original members, although many moons ago myself and Freeman were in our first band together which wasn't as political as Disarm...

2. WOULD (ANY OF) YOU CUT OFF YOUR OWN PENIS IF IT MEANT THAT ALL THE WORLD'S PROBLEMS COULD BE SOLVED?

Newt: This is rather an unusual question. Although I'll answer it truly. After thought, yes I would, cos I could get it cut off in a toilet accident and not achieved anything. And it wouldn't be a problem when it was gone cos there wouldn't be any problems cos cutting it off would have solved them. Although I'll have to have it sewn back on!

3. HAVE DISARM BUILT UP ANY KIND OF FOLLOWING YET?

Newt: Well I think we might have, definately in the valley, but in Cardiff I dont know. They are all really great people and cheer us and that but I dont know if they really like us, or dislike us for that matter!...

4. WHAT DO YOU THINK OF THOSE MONEY-GRABBING SCUM CRICKETERS GOING TO SOUTH AFRICA?... (Unbiased question, eh?)

Newt: Hmm... I've got to be honest, I dont really like cricket and I dont know what the fuss is about. Are they protesting at the airports to stop them coming in? I'm sorry, I dont know much about it...

5. ARE YOU THE WELSH CONFLICT?

Newt: I suppose this question has been answered by everyone who has seen us, we dont think we sound like Conflict. Any likeness is purely from people saying that we sound like them. We just sing the same sort of things. We didn't try to sound like anybody, although it is a compliment in some cases...

6. IN YOUR VIEW WHAT IS/ISN'T PUNK ALL ABOUT?...

Newt: To me, punk has many meanings. Having fun, getting drunk, let nothing get you down (although I'm not good at that!), only do what you think is right and let no one tell you different, look after your friends. **M.D.C. ELVIS IN THE RHEINLAND.** This live LP of all M.D.C classics is just about the best quality live M.D.C material you'll ever get. Obviously B-O-D!! 8/10. Next (Destiny Recs)

**E.N.T. A HOLOCAUST IN YOUR HEAD.** Starts off sounding suprisingly like Conflict, develops into obvious E.N.T stuff. You'll love it if you're into 'em. B.O.D. 8/10. (Head Eruption, 64 Cor-deur Rd, Ipswich, IP4 2XB.

**LIFE CYCLE 'THE WEIGHT OF TRADITION' 12".** This is more like it. Classic grunge-core from Mr Allen's favourite bunch of 'cap-italists' (worra wanka! **POISON IDEA 'IAN MACKAYE' mini LP.** Worra classic!! Uncle Kalv is really spoiling us here. A basic re-release of the now collectable 'Filthkick' EP with 3 other U.S. 7" cuts on the flip. An excellent photo of Ian Mackaye on the cover meets with my whole hearted seal of approval. B.O.D. 10/10. (I.Y.F P.O. Box 203, Nottingham, NG1 3RF)

**CARCASS 'PEEL SESSION'.** Carcass are fucking brilliant. Funnier than Kilddozer, faster than the Incest Brothers, they smash their way through multiple guitar riffs to bass-lines that are as tight as Daz Russel's arse (If you know Mr Russel's sexual practices you'll get the joke) This 12" works out at £1 a track, but if you learn the lyrics well enough you ought to qualify for an open university degree in alternative medicine. Tape or don't. 5/10.

**BAD BRAINS 'QUICKNESS'.** What can I say... £6 a ticket, Virgin distribution. £6.50 price tag for what I can only described as out-takes from the 'I against I' LP. I'll still catch 'em when they play, but I won't view them with respect of latter years. 5/10 (Caroline).

**V/A 'STATE OF THE UNION'.** A dischord comp of DC bands that all sound the same. open chorded musical progression or generic regurgitation of each others admiration for the boringcore capital of the planet? You decide kids. I know which it is and I've been a punka long before your straight edge little bollocks dropped (about last fall if I can remember) Boredom or derlerium? 5/10.

**V/A 'GRINDCRUSHER'.** Yet again another LP on which all the bands sound the same. It's a little more amusing than S.O.T.V as the tracks by Morbid Angel, Carcass, Godflesh and Bolt Thrower must certainly be a musical parody of the U.K hardcore scene. However a £3 price tag for an LP of such UK selling power is excellent, what the fuck's up with Dig doing this? It only leaves me and Mr Militia very confused at this action. The 7" EP contained in this package is the worst wastage of vinyl that I've ever come across. Fuck me, theres innumeral bands that deserve the attention an Earache release would give them. Again, buy or don't.

**DISORDER 'VIOLENT WORLD'.** More classic Disorder. 15 years on and still going strong. From the grandfathers of noisecore comes 13 cuts of sheer brutal megawind torpedo ultra-amargeddon rotting corpse. Catch the classic 'Joleen' and 'Gods are burnin' in the U.S.A' (Lyrics rid dood!) (Disorder Recs/thru Cartel)

**SAW THROAT 'INDESTROY'.** Fuck me, what a suprise!! Sore Throat playing music? Whatever next? Seriously, this LP is 'fuckin' mega. Amebix come Swans? Well whatever it is buy or die dood! (Wicked artwork as well) An atmospheric masterpiece. (Manic Ears) 10/10.

**DOOM/NO SECURITY 'BURY THE DEBT' LP.** Again, this is an improvement on the first LP. A third Chord may well have added a more complex feel to the album, but who am I, a mere mortal, to jibe a Peel band? No seriously, well, are they britcore with yankwank vocals? Maybe! Maybe not. I found some of the lyrics a bit hard to follow, but the one liners in 'Sydafrikafragan' are classic. Goon, you may as well buy it, punk as flip! (Peaceville)

**DECADENCE WITHIN 'THIS LUNACY'.** This is only the second time I've heard this and it's grown on me. My copy arrived in beautiful ecology green wax with lovely John Yates graphix. Has a definite metal feeling to it, probably for the better. Anyway I'm giving it 10/10 cos @they're cool chaps & b) they've got the bollocks to be in a band with Kev McKaye straight-edge God! (Peaceville)

**ELECTRO HIPPIES 'PLAY FAST OR DON'T'.** I've always admired the hippies cos they played mega-ultra ect ect without the hype. This LP was recorded in '86 under one of the earlier line-ups, and has a rawer feel to it than 'dead punk' (Necrosis under the watchfull eye of Earache corporate) 8/10.

**ELECTRO HIPPIES 'LIVE'.** A cheap price tag on this lil' ole 12" This is recorded at their last ever gig, you know, the one they played before that couple of others they did up and down the country. Seriously folks, crackin' quality for a liver, Petesy and Pek must've been thrilled! Buy, buy! 8/10.

**NO MEANS NO 'LARGE PARTS' (Ooo-er).** O.K, so sex mad was fuckin' mega. So how far can a band take an original style and expand it? Bad Brains failed miserably with 'Quickness', but MNM have definitely come out on top here. Their musical ability just shines through. On first hearing one might think it reeks of sex mad, but to a real MNM fan the progression is obvious, my only criticism with MNM is that after seeing them live and hearing this they over-do the stop-start-stop-stop-start multiple riffins a bit. Fuck off and buy!! (Alt Tent) 10/10.

**FUGAZI 'MARGIN WANKER'.** Poo, shit, crap, turd, stool, dung, cakect, ect Drop dead & Buy. (Shitbored) \*\*\*

**TAPES. PLEASANT VALLEY CHILDREN:** Once more, a band shines through the dull sheen that critbire has put on the surface of our once proud and beautiful scene. Little Piggy Rollins & co have come out with a corker here, a simple must. Watch out for the 7" on W.O.W. 10/10. (£1 to Box 32, 52 Call Lane, Leeds LS1 6DT).

**INCEST BROTHERS 'UGLY BUT PROUD'.** Fuckin Hell, this band never cease to amaze me. From the man who proclaims himself a sex god comes seering, biting vocals, aggressively hurling intelligent lyrics in your face. There's not many straight edge bands I rate, but the I.B'S simply blow you away. The music can only be described as 'damaging' and I have heard rumours that to listen to it too much flattens your knob!! Buy, buy, buy, buy, buy, ect. It's a pity they left out their excellent rendition of the Amebix classic 'Axeman'. 15/10. (£1 to Peter John Bottomly-23 Burchett Place, Woodhouse, Leeds, LS 6 2LW).

**BLIND JUSTICE 'ROCK 'N' ROLL VERMIN'.** A new act from Merthyr, Wales. B.J. sound a little too much like the Instigators for my liking, but nevertheless it's musically competent. Goon, buy it. 5/10 (£1 to M. Payne, 6) Lupin Cl, Gurnos Est, M. Tydfil, CF 47 9DW.

**FILTHKICK 'PEEL TAPE'.** 7 cuts of F. Kick taped off Peel. I heard that they sound like Poison Idea, but I think they sound more like E.N.T. with much better riffing, a promising non-metal H/Core act. Blank tape & postage to Autonomy address. 8/10.

**E.N.T./DOOM. LIVE AT VENUE.** Excellent quality live tape of their Cardiff gigs (Autonomy Tapes) C90 & postage (40p). 8/10.  
**CONCRETE SOX/INTENSE DEGREE/HOTALACIO.** Again good quality live in Cardiff. 8/10. C90 & postage. (Autonomy tapes)

**NAPALM DEATH. LIVE CARDIFF.** Recorded through 4 track portastudio B-side live in '86. £2 (Benefit for @nticash) Autonomy tapes c/o 5 Millrace cl, Lisvane, Cardiff, CF4 5UR.

Being a punkgod has it's off moments, but as long as their are bands like Rectify, Life Cycle, Next World, Pink Turds, P.V.C and da bruddas, I'll still spike my hair and act the pissed up twat. Mucus are a fairly recent group (about a year) and the main core of the band is Kris (me!!) on vocals and occasionally bass, Lyndon on another bass with overdrive and Anthony on drums. We originally began with a guitarist Paul and we did a few covers of Black Sabbath, Artphag and Napalm Death. Then we recruited a new guitarist Sam who is still in the band but has only ever practiced with us once!! (inconsistent or what?). Eventually we wrote some of our own material as I found doing cover versions so empty, no imagination goes into them and about March '89 the tape was released entitled "If we could play...we'd be dangerous!!" we sold more copies than we expected. The money was then put towards travel expenses and the practice room. Due to lack of money income of the band we have very little equipment, borrowing stuff all the time. Our first gig was at the beginning of April and we went down quite well, but the problem was no-one was paying us any close attention as we made up two songs on the spot and nobody noticed!! The majority of songs were silly but have recently been getting more and more political and social in their subject matter.

Influences? Well I don't think there are many on the music side apart from Sore Throat (Yeeeah!! - the Thrashoholics), but my current fave listenings are Jello Biafra (all his work I've found interesting, especially D.K.'s Frankenchrist LP), Civilised Society? (whatever happened to these?), Electro Hippies (ditto!), Fugazi and a list as long as your arm. Lyndon listens to Sonic Youth, Bulthole Surfers, Doom, Loop and another long, long list.

Anthony listens to mainly thrash but has some hardcore influences. Taking a few questions from one of your other interviews. We don't like our first demo much as a lot of the material on their is badly written. The production is also terrible. My favourite bits are "The curse of Karen Carpenter" (You'd be suprised how many people don't know who she is!), "Trev's boss", "Avon calling" (I like drumming for a laugh!), "Electric Toothbrush Slaughter" (takes the piss out of one second songs), "Anthrax Song" is okay and thats about it. We still play "Chainsaw" and "Feedback" and sometimes "Anarchic Aardvarks" but not the other four.

Pet hates? Well I can't speak for the rest of the band by myself, but I dislike my old man(!), CCFC soul crew and the like and people who try to force beliefs on you're religion, racism, etc.

Future plans? Lyndon is leaving Logo and live in Manchester, so we're auditioning bassists (Well, we're looking for someone with a bass!!) 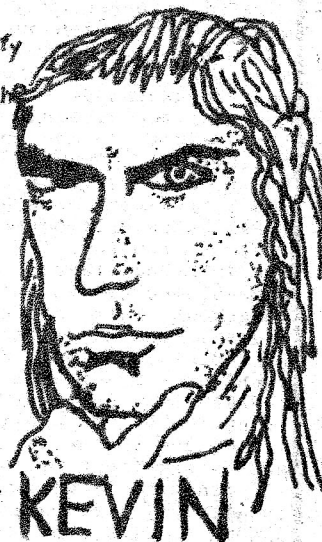
The shop-assistants manner on realising what was happening, turned into a kind of authoritarian frustration. "Now you come back with that muesli at once, do you hear me?"

AF:HOW LONG HAVE FILTHKICK BEEN GOING?

L:How long have we been going, well you answer me this..How long have bears plopped in the woods?How long is a piece of string, and why are penguins blue?Huh, Huh!

J:Well, we first practised in Jan '89 though with a different drummer.

AF:WHY DID YOU START FILTHKICK?

L:As a statement against the price of Tequila!...Something to do you know, bored youth on the dole, keeps us away from street corners.

J:After my previous band involvement (Ripcord) ceased in Nov '88 my immediate reaction was "where to next?". Somewhere during an inebriated conversation with Leggo, who was with Deviated Instinct at the time, we decided that starting a new band was a worthwhile thing to do, especially as he was a tad bored with how progressively 'metal' DI were getting. A formula of playing basic h/c punk was decided upon & eventually acted upon when I found a friend (Mark) could play guitar & a mate Ben had a drum kit though he has now been replaced by Stick.

AF:HAVE THE BAND EXPERIENCED ANY DIFFICULTIES IN GETTING OFF THE GROUND?

L:Yeh, we had to use a crane to lift Jim off the ground!!

J:Initiall we had a problem with drummers not really being able to play the sort of stuff we wanted to do though luckily Marks' friend Ben came along which proved to be 3rd time lucky. Aside from that things have gone pretty smoothly. We were lucky getting the offer of a Peel sess. (He was at an ENT gig in Ipswich that we also played). It was a bit rough musically as it was, collectively, our first time in a studio & neither Mark or Ben had been in a studio before, especially one as technical as the BBC's Maida Vale set up. Still, it could have been worse & it did save us the cost of recording a demo!

AF:HAVE YOU BEEN DOING MUCH GIGGING UP AND DOWN THE COUNTRY?

L:The only trouble with gigs in this country is they're getting crapper & crapper! (did you know that it was Thomas Crapper who invented the toilet, to which I owe my livelihood!-Ed) Lower turnouts, huge door prices etc etc. General apathy towards bands who are not part of the h/c elite eg: The ones in the music press every week. Come on boys & girls let's get our acts together before the whole thing goes down the pan! (talking of pans..did you know that Thomas...Ed)

J:We've played a fair few gigs around the place of late but that's probably because we put a stop to playing any more Birnham gigs this year as it was getting to be a state of overkill & I think that people were getting sick of seeing us.



# FLAT KICK

AF: WHAT ARE YOUR GOALS/ASPIRATIONS FOR THE BAND?

L: To get to play on the Des O'Connor show, or do sound tracks for extremely tacky Danish films!!...Just to do a few gigs, a few records, & maybe make a few folk think through our lyrics....Sign to Earache & turn Death Metal!!! Ha Ha Ha!!  
J: I suppose this sounds dull but no, I personally haven't got nor want some sort of master plan. That sort of thing I find restrictive & to an extent rather pointless. I'm happy with a situation whereby we maintain some sort of integrity as a band and as individuals where we have our own artistic freedom not being controlled by any outside entities. I'd like to attain a reasonable degree of musical skill but I'll do that at my own pace & in my own time. I'm happy with the fact that I'm a more competent bassist than I was in other involvements. I guess that's an aspiration achieved, all be it a modest one. As far as making records goes, I'd like each one to be a step forward from its predecessor. But you learn from experience. If anything is to be said overall on this question, I'd rather be happy.

AF: WHAT DO YOU THINK OF THE CURRENT STATE OF THE UK PUNK THANG?

L: Bullshit!! Perhaps when the media interest disappears we can get back to the real thing. It's deader than ever, diluted by the tame copying of American bands, squeezed dry by money-grabbing record labels & kicked in the teeth by gossip mongers & petty bickering - don't point the finger at me until you look in the mirror.

J: Aside from the usual bitching & petty stubbornness & shallowness in a minority of quarters, for today at least I think it's healthy enough to rise above the one upmanship & mind games. There are enough committed, active & down to earth people to keep it ticking over nicely. A slow stream of new faces regularly becoming a part of things is a good sign more often than not. Tomorrow I may well feel differently, more or less inspired, but I know in the end that nothing could replace it.

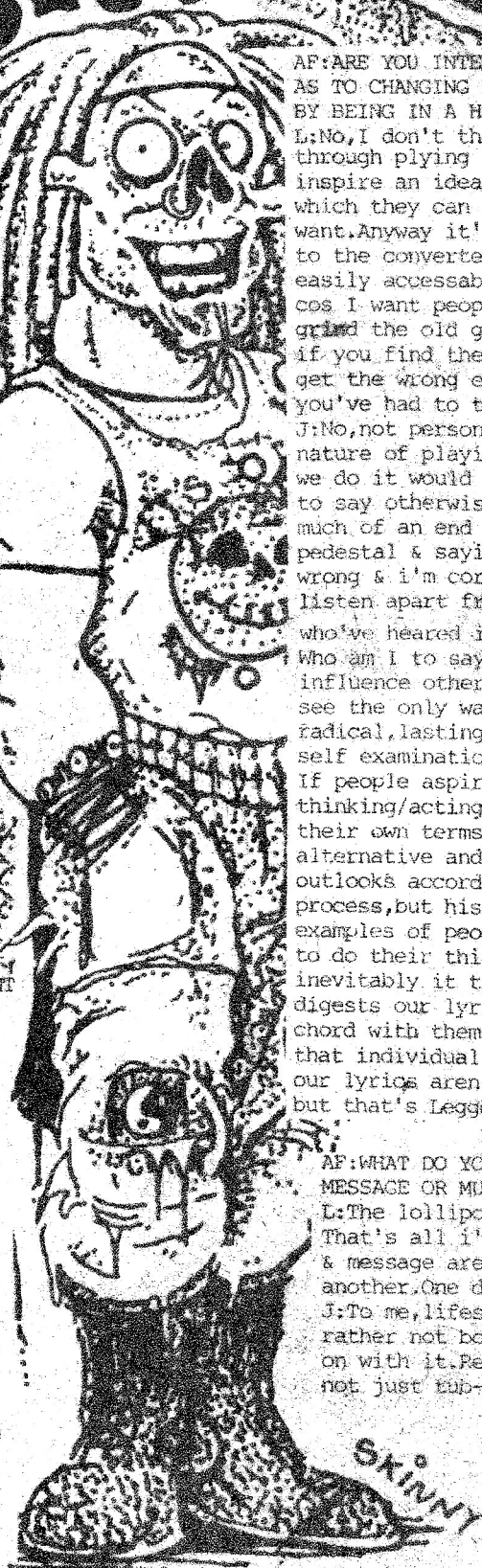
AF: ARE YOU INTENT ON MAKING ANY ACHIEVEMENTS AS TO CHANGING PEOPLE'S WAY OF THINKING BY BEING IN A HARDCORE BAND?

L: No, I don't think you can change anything through plying this tuneless dross!! Maybe inspire an idea or two in someones head, which they can take whichever way they want. Anyway it's a pretty much "preaching to the converted" syndrome. I don't write easily accessible lyrics, or 'safe' lyrics, cos I want people to read into them, then grab the old grey matter into action. Even if you find the lyrics sit or offensive, get the wrong end of the stick, at least you've had to think, & that's all I want.

J: No, not personally anyway. By the very nature of playing the sort of stuff that we do it would be silly, even pretentious to say otherwise. I don't think there's much of an end result in getting on a pedestal & saying "Listen to me, you're wrong & I'm correct", who's going to listen apart from the drop in the ocean who've heard it all a million times before? Who am I to say that the way I exist should influence others and their perspectives? I see the only way of achieving the sort of radical, lasting, peaceful change is by self examination and perhaps by example. If people aspire to a different way of thinking/acting then it has to be on their own terms of seeing a viable alternative and adjusting their own outlooks accordingly. A slow if impossible process, but history is fraught with examples of people entrusting leaders to do their thinking for them and inevitably it turns sour. If someone digests our lyrics and it strikes a chord with them then that's a down to that individual, though on the whole our lyrics aren't immediately 'obvious', but that's Leggos' way of doing things.

AF: WHAT DO YOU THINK THE MOST IMPORTANT, MESSAGE OR MUSIC?

L: The lollipops after the show mate. That's all I'm in it for! The music & message are just as important as one another. One doesn't work without the other.  
J: To me, lifestyle incorporates both. I'd rather not bother separating & just get on with it. Real people make this 'scene', not just tub-thumpers & cock-rockers.

AF: ARE ANY OF YOU INVOLVED IN DIRECT ACTION?

L: Ooo-err, i'm a lazy liberal bastard like all brummies! content to rot in my own apathy, while the world falls apart around me.

J: On a person basis - ie boycotting certain consumables Vegetarianism then yes but none of us wield baseball bats to the craniums of vivisectionists, Tories, coppers, poll tax collectors. Even if Leggo & I have had many a good conversation as to the merits of owning a shotgun & how & when to use one!!! Excuse my lapse into momentary fantasy, but living around here warrants being entertained such possibilities quite often!

I'm less optimistic about what seems to be segregation creeping in, where you're judged by how you dress, who you listen to, who you associate with, who you slag off etc... too much of that goes on in the 'outside world', & we are supposedly 'different'? Pull the other one pal! The prevailing lack of sense of humour & tolerance also tends to piss me off sometimes - when people start taking themselves too seriously it parallels religious fanaticism of sorts. Anyway, better or worse, it's what we all chose to make it.....

AF: HAVE YOU BEEN FUCKED OVER BY ANYBODY SUPPOSEDLY IN THE SCENE LATELY?

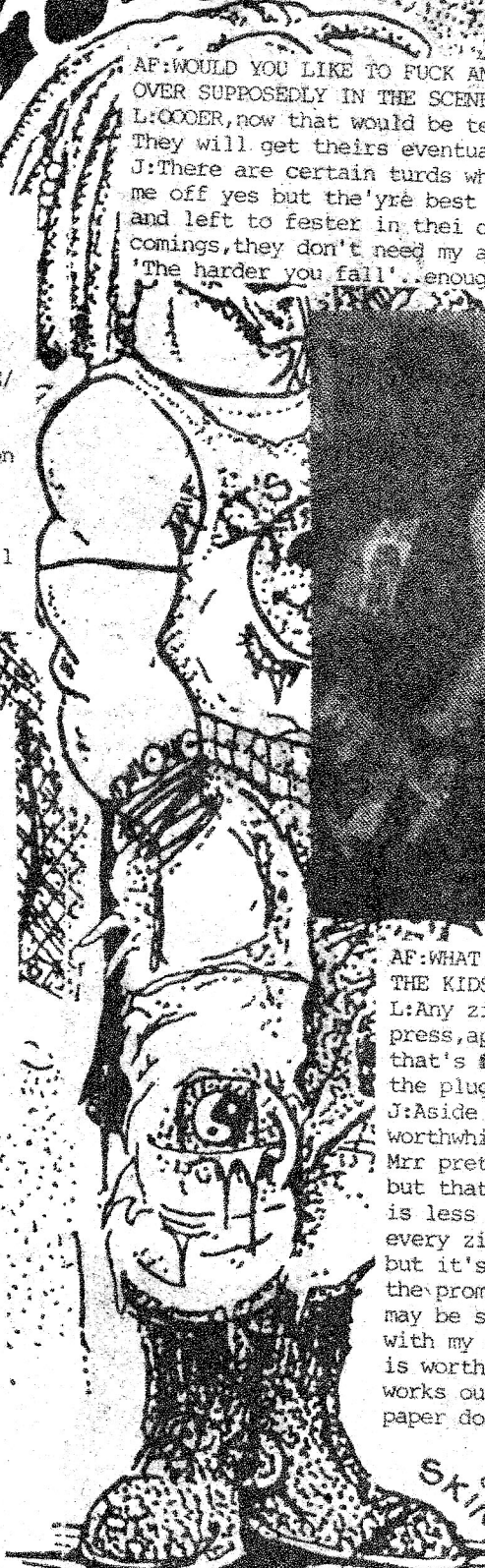
L: I got fucked over a log by Jim t'other day! Very gentle he was too!

AF: WHAT DO YOU THINK OF THE EXPOSURE THAT SOUNDS/SNUB/PEEL AND OTHER FORMS OF MAINSTREAM MEDIA HAS GIVEN THE UK HARDCORE THING?

L: Sounds, & the whole music press are only giving us exposure because punk has come round again as some mundane marketable commodity. Don't be fooled-cos you're not getting your views across to more people, cos they have total editorial control. They're only interested in the music & the bickering, they're just patronising everything you've ever stood for. Fuck 'em, we don't need 'em, they need us. I think our song "Between The Lines" sums this all up.

~ Snub is a joke.

Peel has always supported punk, right from the start. I've noticed a lot of slagging towards bands that have done Peel sessions-why-cos you're too narrow minded kiddies. We've done a Peel session & we haven't sold our souls to the demon BBC. We've so far had £400 for a six hour recording session-bargain! we haven't ripped anyone off for this, apart from maybe the BBC. We're not releasing on Strange Fruit (Teh, they are a rip-off). I can't remember Crass getting slagged off for doing a session, are they allowed to then?!

J: Of the three examples I only rate Peels interest as genuine, to the others we're disposable non-entities cos that's how they sustain their market, give the kiddies a new toy & they'll forget that we sold them the last one. Sure, I make a point of reading most of the weekly rags, call it habit or amusement it usually falls to the latter these days. As to the value of the exposure, certainly new people have been introduced as a result but do we really owe them credit for that? I think not, it's too early to asses any achievement (if any) via the medias interest as they've not yet really started to bury us.

AF: DO ANY OF THE BAND BELONG TO ANY POLITICAL ORGANISATIONS?

L: Yeh, 'Big noses and ass lickers getting into gigs for nothing 'party'!

J: In a word, no. Having said that I did vote last time round (Green party) but i've no political allegiance specifically, I think the others think similarly.

AF: WHAT IS MORE IMPORTANT TO YOU AS A BAND, YOUR MUSICAL DIRECTION OR YOUR INDEPENDANT STATUS?

L: You can do whatever you want musically without selling out! Independence is the most important, jolly jolly important!

J: Being independant as is comfortable means that we can do what we like musically or otherwise so as an "either"/"or" situation i'd go for the latter in order of importance. If we ever got to the position whereby we were offered anything that remotely affected doing what we wanted then i'd have to severely question what I was doing.

AF: HAVE YOU ANY PLANS FOR FURTHER VINYL?

J: Our shared l.p. is now available (with ENT-7 new songs from each of us), that's on Pete's (ENT) own label. We also have a full l.p. planned for Raging records which we've not yet recorded but hope to soon. Hopefully that will be available in early 1990. After that-who knows. There's talk of a comp. e.p. of local bands but nothing concrete yet-Andy (Discarded/Give Me Crust zine) might do something along those lines-we'll see.

AF: WOULD YOU CARE TO REPEAT ANY MISTAKES THAT YOU'VE MADE BY BEING IN A H/C BAND?

L: Nah mate, i'm perfect!! Yeh, thousands, most involving my big mouth! Oh well, "better to regret something you have done than to regret something you haven't"!

J: Any mistakes you make on the path of life you try to avoid making again if it causes discomfort or whatever. Sometimes you trust people at face value & then find out the facade masks something you should have known better to avoid. I guess I believe 'once bitten twice shy' but you can't be cynical about everyone, well I try not to be anyway. Other peoples' mistakes never seem to hit as hard as your own, a matter of pride perhaps?
