

Chocolate Egg Pedestal Box

Supplies Needed:

Note: all punches, card stock, inks and embellishments used are from Stampin' Up!

My Creative Time "Happy Hunting" stamp set (greetings)
My Creative Time "Hello Spring" stamp set with die (die egg)
Everyday Enchantment designer series paper & brads
Riding Hood Red card stock
Very Vanilla card stock
Riding Hood Red ink pad
Basic Black ink pad
Round Tab paper punch
3/4" Circle paper punch
1-1/4" Circle paper punch
Scallop Border paper punch
Boho Blossoms paper punch
Spellbinders Scallop Circle Nestabilities die
Spellbinders Label 1 Nestabilities die
Big Shot or other die cutting machine
5/8" Very Vanilla satin ribbon
5/8" Early Espresso Vanilla satin ribbon
3/8" Riding Hood Red taffeta ribbon

3/8" Riding Hood Red pleated satin ribbon

Clear window sheet/acetate

Sticky Strip, Mono Multi Glue, Dimensionals

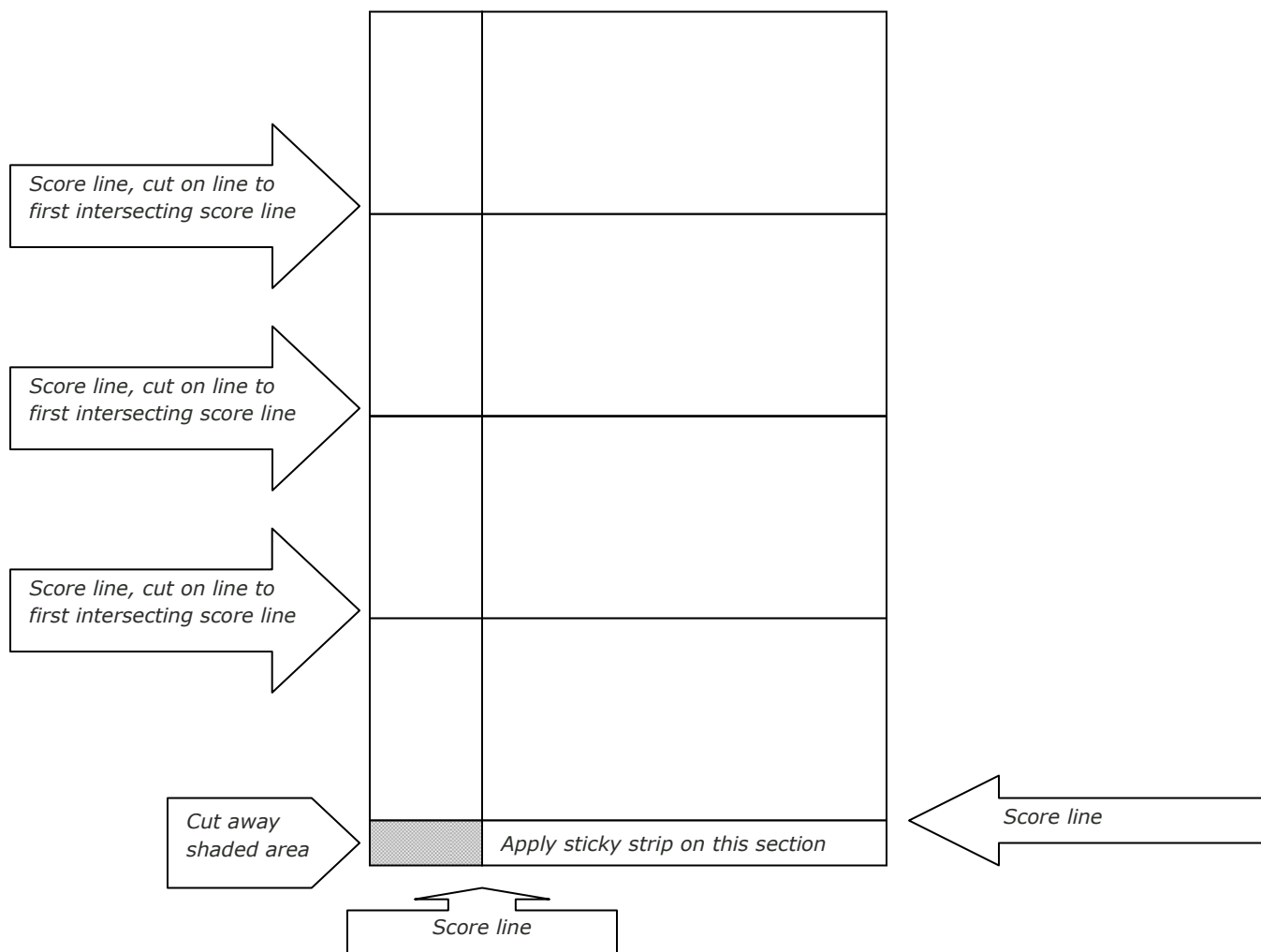
Paper Cutter, Scissors, Bone Folder, Scoring Board (or score blade for paper cutter)

Cadbury Chocolate Egg

Egg Pedestal Box Assembly Instructions:

Step 1

Cut a 4" x 9-1/2" piece of window sheet (acetate or transparency). On the short side, score at 1-1/4". On the long side score at 1/2", 2-3/4", 5", 7-1/4". Cut on lines as indicated in the diagram. Sharpen score lines. Apply sticky strip to 1/2" wide section. Assemble open top box with Sticky Strip.



Step 2

Cut a 3-3/16" x 3-3/16" piece of Riding Hood Red card stock. Score at 1/2" on all four sides. Clip on one of the 1/2" score lines at each corner as shown. Cut a tiny wedge on each side of the corner tabs. This way, the corners fold in more precisely. Fold one side of up. Slide the 1-1/4" Circle punch to the center and punch. Secure the corners to form the egg holder. Place in the bottom of clear display box.

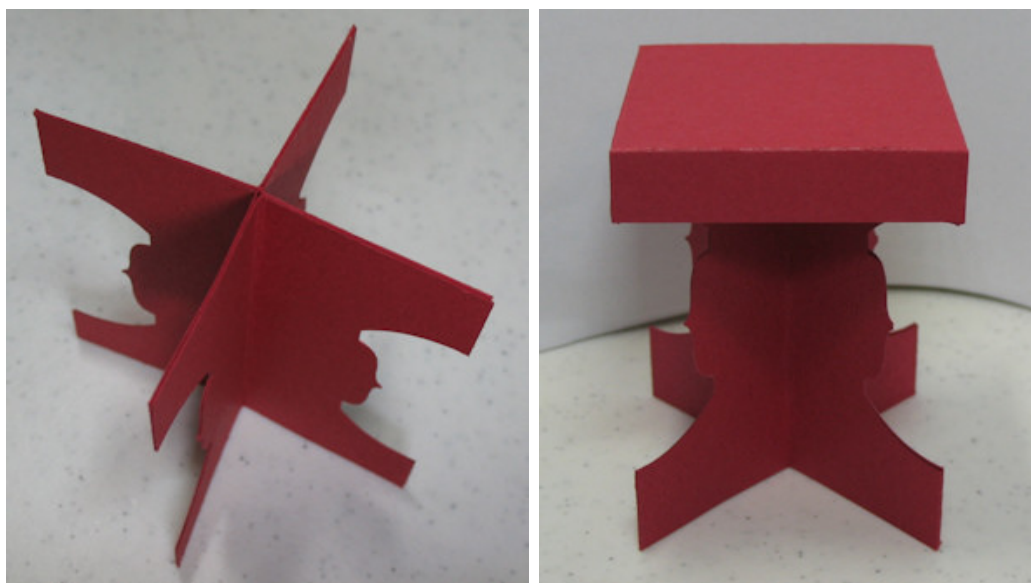


Step 3

Cut four 3-1/8" x 3-1/8" pieces of Riding Hood Red card stock. Fold each piece in half. Slide the Round Tab punch onto one side, aligning one edge at the center score line and inserting the card stock as far as it will go into the punch. After punching one side, punch the other side in the same manner (don't flip over and punch on the same side you just did or the four pieces will not align perfectly).



Punch all four pieces in the same manner. Align the edges of the 4 pieces and glue in place to form the pedestal. Cut a 3-5/16" x 3-5/16" piece of Riding Hood Red card stock. Score at 1/2" on all sides. Clip on one 1/2" score line at each corner to form tabs. Secure tabs with glue at the corners. Place finished piece onto pedestal.



Step 4

Attach the egg box to the top of the pedestal stand (I suggest setting the pedestal legs aside for now). Cut a strip of 1-1/2" x 10" designer series paper. Punch one edge with Scallop Border punch. Wrap around base of egg box, aligning top with top of egg holder inside of box. Pinch edges to sharpen creases. Tape to outside of box. Cut a 10" length of pleated satin ribbon and attach to box with sticky strip.

Cut a 3-5/16" x 3-5/16" piece of designer series paper. Score at 1/2" on all sides. Clip on 1/2" score on each corner. Secure tabs at corners to form box lid. Tie a piece of satin ribbon into bow and attach to top of box with sticky strip.

Punch Boho Blossoms out of designer series paper. Pierce hole into center of each flower and layer onto designer brad. Flatten fastener on back. Attach flower to Cadbury Chocolate Egg with dimensional. Put egg in box and place lid on top. Put box back on pedestal legs.



Card Assembly

Cut the following pieces of card stock:

8-1/2" x 5-1/2" Very Vanilla (card base)

4" x 5-1/4" Riding Hood Red

3-7/8" x 5-1/8" floral designer series paper

3-7/8" x 1-1/2" polka dot designer series paper

3-7/8" x 1-5/8" Riding Hood Red

Die cut the solid red print with Nestabilities Label 1 die and cut in half. Stamp greeting on bottom of piece with basic black ink. Layer floral print onto riding hood red card stock. Attach die cut piece at bottom right corner. Layer smaller riding hood red strip along top of die cut. Layer polka dot paper on top of this strip. Wrap a length of vanilla satin ribbon around riding hood red base and tie bow on the right. Attach entire piece to the very vanilla card stock.

Die cut the larger egg out of riding hood red small dot print paper. Sponge edge with riding hood red ink. Punch a 3/4" circle into very vanilla card stock. Stamp circle greeting with riding hood red ink over top of punched circle. Die cut greeting with Nestabilities Scallop Circle die. Tie a riding hood red taffetta ribbon around egg and tie knot in front. Attach greeting circle over top of ribbon with dimensionals. Attach egg to card with dimensionals.
